Get a Box Brownie camera and take some photos.

The exhibition will be at ICEWORKS in Lakes Entrance at Easter 2024 (March 30 – April 6)

PARAMETERS AND OTHER INFORMATION

1. Photos **MUST** be taken using a Box Brownie camera – a BOX model similar to the graphic above (see model info below)
2. If inclined photos can be manipulated – or left as developed
3. Up to 5 photos per entry
4. Entry fee is \$20
5. Photos can be for sale – a 20% commission will apply
6. Photos to be delivered by 25 March
7. Photos to be mounted on backing board or framed with D hooks and wire
8. A copy of any original Box Brownie photos that inspired your photos can be included for display (mounted on 150 x 150 board)
9. Box Brownie cameras used can also be included in your display if you wish – and their history or family connection
10. A brief CV or other information on the photographer is also welcome
11. All care will be taken but no liability will be incurred.

Box Brownies were manufactured from 1900 to 1968 – acceptable models are:

Brownie No.2 (1901 – 35); Brownie 2A (1909 – 11); Beau brownie (1930 – 33);

*Brownie Flash 111 (1957 – 60). The **Brownie Camera Page** has all the information you need.*

Film is available in various places including – Film Never Die in Melbourne and Foons Photographic in Wonthaggi – who also develop.

Film can be developed onto paper or digitally.
